This is an individual chess tournament. You do not have to be part of a chess team or program to play, but there are team prizes in each section for the top schools. This is not an elimination tournament - players will play all four rounds.

DOUBLE CHECK YOUR REGISTRATION

All players/parents should check their information on the [entry list](#), including:

- Section (K-12, K-5, K-3, PK-1)
- School Code (confirm that your school code matches your schoolmates)
- Byes - byes are rounds that you are not playing. You should only select byes if you must skip a certain round.

You do **NOT** need to check in on-site for the tournament. Confirm your information on the [entry list](#), and just show up to the first round at 10:00am.

Pairings will be posted physically at the tournament site as well as [online](#). It will be easiest to check pairings, standings, and team standings online. This is a US Chess rated tournament - USCF membership is required - renew online [here](#).

Masks are required for all. All chess equipment is provided, including boards and clocks.

Parents are responsible for student supervision. "Drop off" is permitted, but tournament staff are not available to supervise outside of the tournament room.
