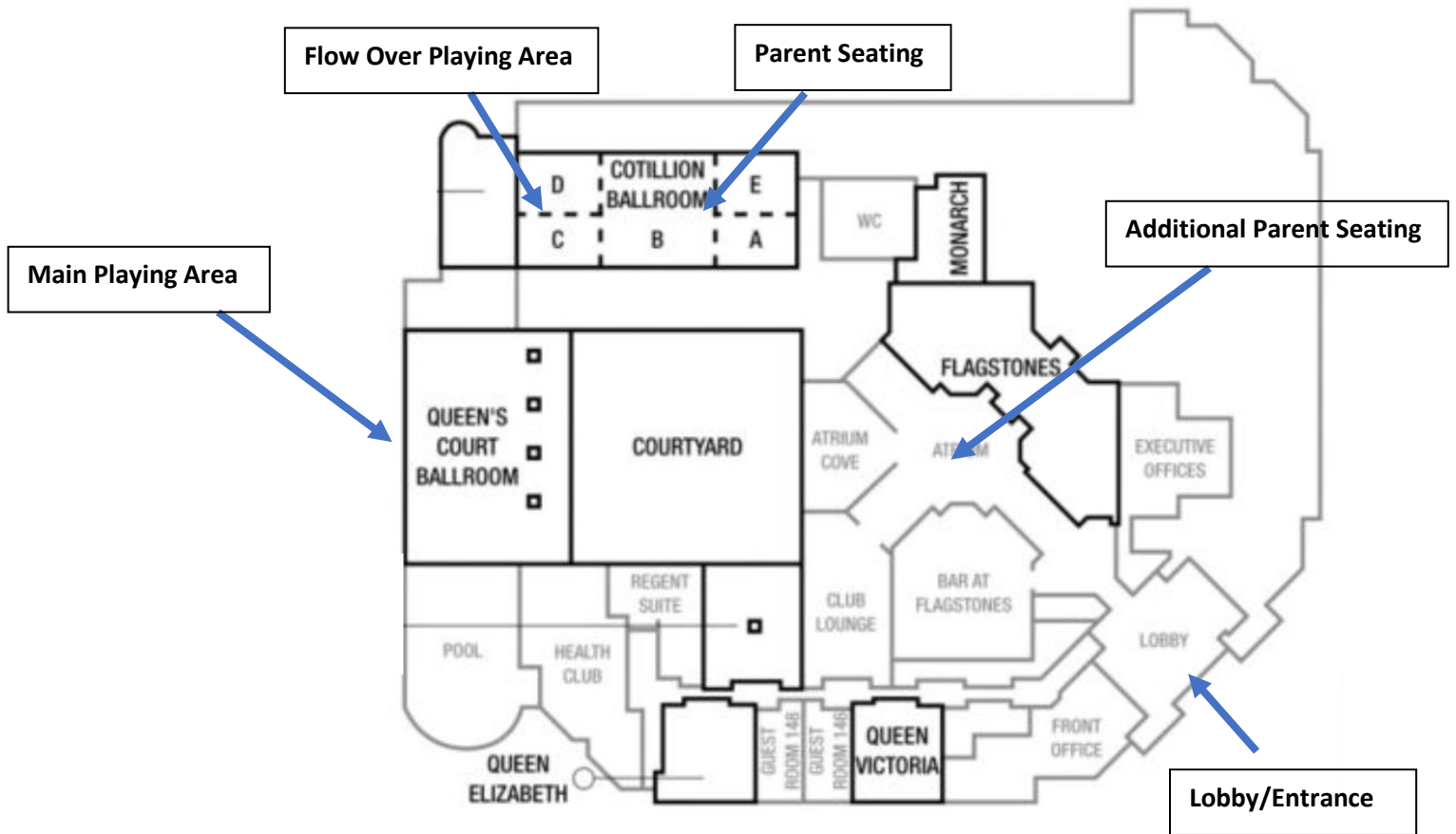
Students are expected to play every round, win, lose, or draw. It is not an elimination event.
